Full-time 12-month position available August 1, 2022. Rural school district located in Venango County with approximately 817 students; 120 employees; 2021-22 budget approximately 16.5 million. Minimum requirement for this administrative position is a bachelor's degree in Business Administration with a major in accounting. PA Registered School Business Administrator or Official (PRSBA or PRSBO) certification preferred, but not required. Individuals possessing a Master of Business Administration (MBA) degree or Certified Public Accountant (CPA) license along with school business administrative experience may also apply. Effective leadership, supervision, communication and interpersonal skills required.

Responsibilities of the position include, but are not limited to budget preparation under Act 1 regulations, financial and debt management, state/local audits, payroll supervision, employee benefits, insurances, transportation reporting, overseeing food service operations, tax administration, duties of school board secretary, and contract negotiations.
